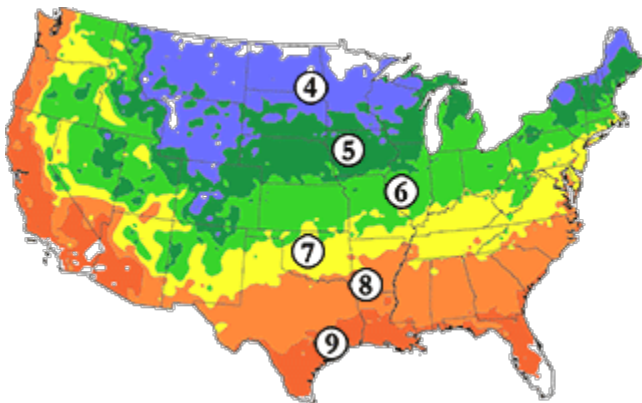

Ichi Ki Kei Jiro Persimmon

This tree is the Ichi Ki Kei Jiro, the hardiest of all Asian persimmons. The name translates to “first life from Jiro”. Nicknamed “Itchy,” this bountiful bearer features seedless, pucker-free fruit that is never sour — it’s sweet even when picked firm like an apple! It starts producing medium to large orange fruit in 2-3 years. At maturity, the Ichi Ki Kei Jiro reaches a height and width of 8-10 feet and is considered a dwarf. This non-astringent persimmon ripens in September or October and is self-pollinating.
